Orilla Mail was developed from the ground up as the last e-mail solution you will use; an independently developed e-mail system that is not bloated with features you will never use to raise the license price. With a comprehensive list of core features such as POP3, SMTP IMAP & AFT the foundation on which Orilla Mail operates was built. This allows us to offer Orilla Mail at an astoundingly competitive price point.

Orilla Mail is the service that keeps your vessel safe from malicious attachments and combines all the needed features in one product with the ability to use it on every data connection.

Orilla Mail gives you the basic features needed to connect your favourite e-mail client such as POP3, SMTP and IMAP. These services can be used without any additional fees as we want to offer a full e-mail experience.

Most vessels use the e-mail system provided by their airtime provider, only allowing you to use the system via their airtime or you have to pay a high fee to use it via alternative connections.

Orilla Mail was developed as an independent e-mail solution that gives you the power of choice. You are no longer tied to one airtime provider, Orilla Mail puts you in control. It gives you the freedom to use the data connection you prefer. Close to port? Use 3G or 4G. VSAT or FBB not working? Use Iridium. Would you like to switch to another airtime provider to obtain the lowest costs? Feel free to switch, you will still keep the same e-mail address and mail system.

Low cost and compatible with all airtime providers

Orilla Mail is not an e-mail client such as Outlook but a pure connector, meaning the Orilla Mail system will establish the satellite link allowing you to connect with any client you use such as Outlook or Thunderbird.



WEBPORTAL CONTROL

Using the Orilla Mail web portal you can create mailboxes, configure size and other restrictions for inbound and outbound messages, and set file imports and exports. You can manage settings per vessel or per fleet, allowing you to easily control the settings of the vessel/vessels you are managing. There is no restriction on the number of mailboxes that you can create.

One of the key features of Orilla Mail is its full integration with our IRIS service, IRIS will scan all incoming attachments with a multitude of award winning Antivirus software in order to reduce the possibility that an infection reaches the vessel to zero.


CREWMAIL INCLUDED

- Crew e-mail is standard included, no extra fee is charged. Allowing crew on board to stay in contact with family and friends;
- Crew e-mail can be limited on size to avoid crew member sending large messages;
- Mailboxes can be transferred from vessel to vessel to allow crew members to take their e-mails with them if they switch vessels within your organisation.

Free back-ups compliment the Orilla Mail package, giving you an extra layer of security in case something goes wrong. By opting in it configures our servers to make back-ups of all incoming and outgoing e-mails. Singtel ensures that all e-mails will be available at no additional cost.
