

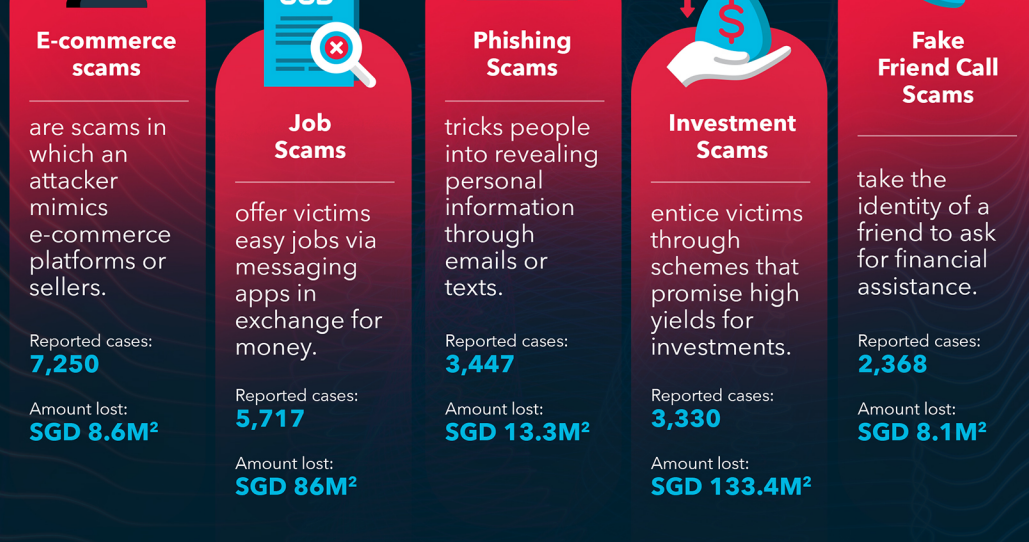

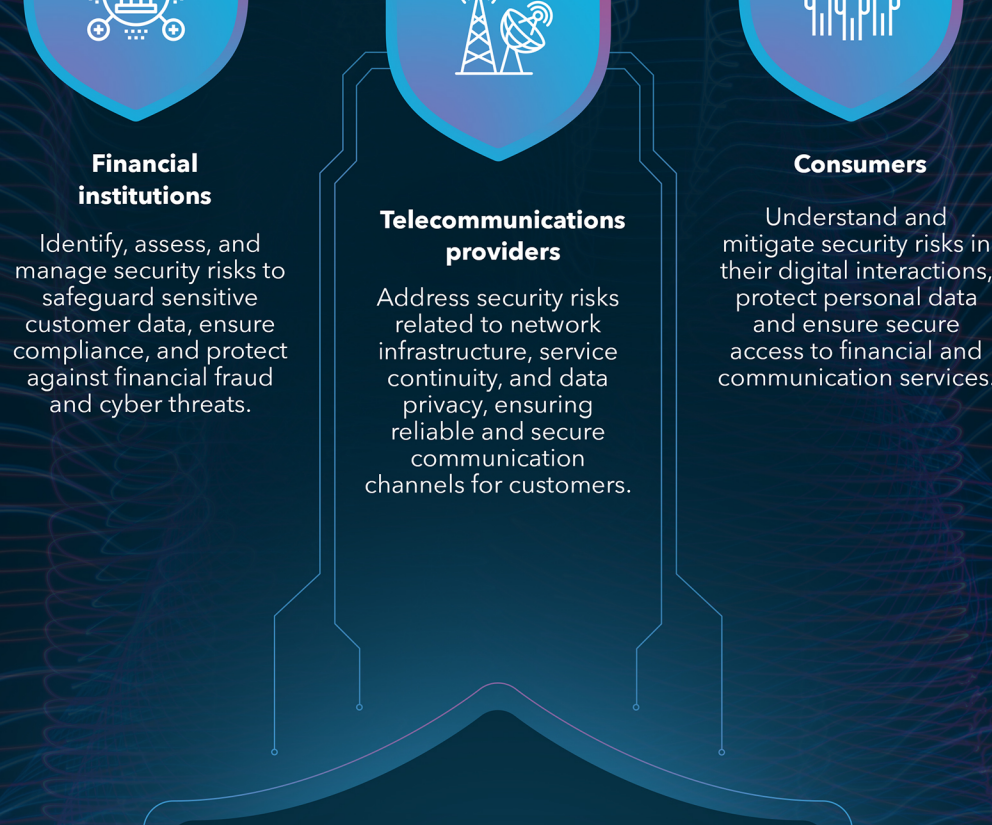
The changing faces of scams for businesses
